Just south of E Dean Keeton, bounded by San Jacinto Blvd on the east side and Speedway Drive on the west side.

Visitor Parking Garage: UT San Jacinto Parking Garage, 2401 San Jacinto Boulevard

Loading Zone Parking: UT Loading Dock Lot 25. Near 301 E Dean Keeton St. Entrance at south side of E Dean Keeton St., just west of the SW corner of E Dean Keeton St & San Jacinto Blvd.

PARKING GARAGE VALIDATION/CHASER TICKETS

Visitor parking is available in the UT San Jacinto Parking Garage, 2401 San Jacinto Boulevard.

- If the Visitor is representing a company, here to pitch a product or otherwise meeting with ECE for a product or service that ECE is paying for, typically ECE would not provide parking validation. (Also, Loading Zone may be appropriate; see separate information.)
- If the Visitor is a Department Guest, invited by & hosted by Chairman for a ECE Dept. meeting or event: ECE Chair and Exec Asst maintain a supply of parking validation tickets to distribute to official guests of the Dept. as appropriate. The parking validation ticket supply maintained by Exec Asst and Chair are purchased on a depth account by the Procurement Officer, and the supply is maintained by the Exec Asst and Chair.
- If the Visitor is <u>not</u> a Department Guest, rather is being hosted by a faculty member or research group/ORU:
 Parking must be charged to a faculty account (30-endowed or gift account).

If the faculty member is not supported by research staff, ECE Procurement Officer will arrange the purchase funded by the faculty member's 30-account and provide tickets to the faculty member.

If the faculty is in a group supported by research staff, all related administrative processes should be done by a research staff member including purchasing tickets from UT P&T Svcs with that group's or faculty member's funds.

Visitor Parking Instructions

- 1. San Jacinto Parking Garage, 2401 San Jacinto Boulevard_ https://parking.utexas.edu/parking/garages/san-jacinto-garage-sjg
- 2. Upon entrance to Garage, pull a regular ticket from the automated dispenser, and retain this ticket in your vehicle.
- 3. When you walk out of the parking garage, you'll cross to the west side of the street, San Jacinto Blvd, at the sidewalk turn right headed north towards the EER building which will be on your left at the small bridge that crosses the creek.

(If you are an invited guest of the Department Chair or of a Faculty Member, please check with your host ahead of time on whether parking validation arrangements apply.)

Loading Zone Parking

The Dept. of ECE is located within the Engineering Research and Education Center (EER) (yellow arrow, top rt). EER's loading dock is located behind the ECJ Building in UT Loading Zone Lot 25. Lot 25 is accessible from the ECJ Building Service Drive, entrance from the south side of E Dean Keeton Street, near the sw corner of E Dean Keeton and San Jacinto Blvd.

A good reference to find the ECJ service drive is the pedestrian bridge that crosses E Dean Keeton between Speedway Drive and San Jacinto Blvd. The ECJ Service Drive is just east of the pedestrian bridge. The loading zone allows 30-minute parking without a permit but vehicle MUST HAVE emergency/flashing lights on. Do not park in any areas marked fire zone.



UT Lot 25 Loading Zone: Parking Allowed with Emergency/Flashing Lights on <u>At All Times</u> for 30 minutes max. Map: Entrance just west of the SW corner of E Dean Keeton St & San Jacinto Blvd.

Photo: Within Lot 25, you will park at any signed "Loading Zone" area; do not park in fire zone. Leave vehicle's emergency/flashing lights on, & walk on the sidewalk alongside the EER building pictured on the right.
