### NOTES:

- No more than six hours or two (2) undergraduate upper-division (content-based, non-language) courses can be counted towards your graduate degree.
- No more than six hours or two individual study (2) conference courses (content-based, non-language) courses can be counted towards your graduate degree.
- No language courses may be counted towards your degree with the exception of 4<sup>th</sup> year/advanced courses taught as a content course entirely in an REE area foreign language.
- Students are required to pass an Oral Proficiency Interview with an OPI-certified instructor in the REE language of their choice at the Advanced-Low (ACTFL scale) in order to graduate.
- Students are required to be enrolled in a REE 698B or REE 398R the semester they graduate and must submit their thesis or report to the Office of Graduate Studies on or before the last class day with all required paperwork and signatures: <https://gradschool.utexas.edu/academics/theses-and-dissertations>.
- Courses in any department may be taken for elective credit so long as the instructor sends written notification to the graduate coordinator that 30% of the course is on the REE region (content, grades, etc)
