LEVELS OF INVOLVEMENT

A few examples of how much involvement a project entails, from low to high

ONE-OFF EVENT: ORGANIZER

You find internal speakers, such as fellow advanced degrees or faculty, to participate in a one-time program. Increased involvement: secure a speaker external to the university or arrange a panel of external speakers.

ONE-OFF EVENT: CREATOR

You develop the content for a one-time program and then lead the session yourself. Increased involvement: you coordinate with other relevant stakeholders to develop and colead programming involving multiple relevant speakers, yourself included.

PROGRAMMING SERIES

You organize, identify speakers, develop content, or otherwise work to put on a series of related events that present a coherent, supportive professional development program.

PROGRAMMING + CONTENT

You develop programming that produces continuously-accessible, high-impact content that can be featured on the TCE website. Increased involvement: content resulting from programming series rather than one-off.
